

DATA SHEET / CONCRETE STAINER

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

A reactive mixture containing special chemicals which reacts with the OPC (Ordinary Portland Cement) in cement/concrete to colour the surface.

BENEFITS:

- Easy application with brush, roller, sponge or spray canister
 - Stains any OPC (Ordinary Portland Cement) based surface
 - Economical application which cannot peel or flake
 - Produces and enhances mottling
 - For use on floors, walls and counters
 - Suitable for interior and exterior use
 - Concrete Stain can be diluted with water if lighter shading is required
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TECHNICAL DETAILS:

<i>Suitable Surfaces</i>	Any OPC (Ordinary Portland Cement) based surface. Newly placed concrete must be cured for at least 14 days prior to application
<i>Finish</i>	Does not change the finish of a surface, only stains it. Will however enhance mottling
<i>Thickness</i>	Adds no thickness to surface
<i>Application</i>	Brush-on, roll-on, sponge-on, spray-on
<i>Packaging</i>	5 litre containers
<i>Coverage</i>	Approximately 8m ² /litre/coat
<i>Curing</i>	All reacted residue must be removed by flushing thoroughly with water after a minimum of 4 hours
<i>Spread Rate</i>	8 to 10 sq. m per litre per coat depending on surface and porosity
<i>Shelf Life</i>	18 Months, some settling in the bottles with occur. This is normal. Shake before use. Note that the concrete stain rust solution is a light green liquid when manufactured. It is prone to a certain degree of oxidation and can turn a rust yellow colour on standing. This will not affect the performance of the product.
<i>Storage</i>	Store in cool dry conditions. Keep container closed.
<i>Colours</i>	Bark & Rust
<i>Washing Tools</i>	Clean water
<i>Health & Safety</i>	Use rubber gloves and goggles when applying. Keep out of the reach of children. Eyes: Wash immediately with water and consult a doctor.
